Making people's lives easier


Providing a public digital means of payment that people could use free of charge for any digital payment in the euro area

- + Standardised, recognisable front-ends



+ Bringing instant payments to the point of sale

Intermediaries would play a key role in distributing digital euro





Digital euro **distribution** would be carried out **exclusively by payment service providers** (PSPs)



PSPs would maintain customer relations



PSPs would benefit from **digital euro open standards**, reducing dependence on international card schemes.
